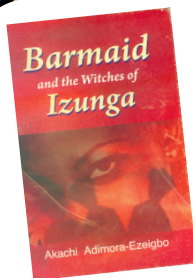

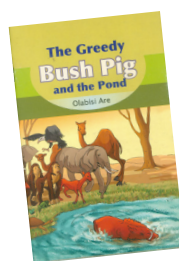

Barmaid and Witches of Izunga

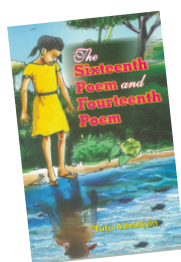
